These stories tell of the history, contributions, and extraordinary resilience of African Americans despite the challenges they faced during slavery, the Jim Crow era, and beyond. The AARCH Society serves as the custodian of historical accuracy through the decades, and stewards a priceless collection of historic documents, photos, maps, objects, video and audio stories, and more. The AARCH Society is continuing this vital work while honoring the past as a bridge to illuminating the future, with its community impact project, the establishment of the African American Heritage Center, opening in 2024.

The Western Maryland Chapter of Jack and Jill of America, Inc, chartered in November 2014, is part of the Eastern Region of Jack and Jill of America, Inc. Jack and Jill of America, Inc., is an organization founded in 1938 with the mission of stimulating the growth and development of children through educational, cultural, civic, recreational, health and social programs inspired by mothers. With more than 262 chapters organized in seven regions across the United States, the organization consists of more than 50,000 family members which includes, mother members, fathers and children ages 2 through 19.

Jack and Jill Chapters also support non-profit organizations through the organization's philanthropic arm, the Jack and Jill of American Foundation, among the first foundations established by African-American families in the United States. Since its founding in 1968, the Foundation has granted millions of dollars to worthy causes supporting children and families. Through lobbying, educational programming, dissemination of education materials, and the organization of community and charitable events, Jack and Jill has promoted the public awareness and interests of children including child development, child growth, child quality of life, child care and the promotion of children's rights.
